

Labrida BioClean® and Covid-19

The situation with Covid-19 has been and still is demanding for dental hygienists, specialists and general practitioners. Dental clinics around the world have long been required to keep closed for all patient care.

A cautious start-up is now taking place in accordance with guidelines given by the local Health Authorities. One of the points that is pervasive in these is a recommendation not to use aerosol-generating instruments, such as ultrasound / USS and high-speed hand pieces. It is well documented that certain viruses and bacteria can be transmitted through aerosols when using such instruments. The brush is used in an oscillating, low-speed hand piece, working in the pocket around the implants and teeth, respectively.
